MINUTES

1. The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 11:00 a.m. on December 5, 2013 in the 3rd floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.
2. Present: Chairman Mark Sievers, Commissioner Thomas Wright, and Commissioner Shari Albrecht
3. The following were approved by the Commission:
 - a. Commissioner Wright moved, and Commissioner Albrecht seconded, the approval of the Consent Agenda: All listed matters for December 5, 2013 on the four page document attached hereto as "Attachment A," which is included by reference herein. Chair Sievers concurred

There being no further matters before the Commission, the Commission adjourned at 11:20 a.m.


