1. **The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on June 17, 2014 in the 3rd floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.**

iv. The Commission moved into Executive Session at 10:35 a.m.


v. The Commission re-convened in public session at 10:55 a.m.

There being no further matters before the Commission, the Commission adjourned at 10:56 a.m.


