- 1) **The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on July 8, 2014 in the 1st floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.**
- 2) Present: Chair Albrecht, Commissioner Emler, and Commissioner Apple.






