MINUTES

The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 9:00 a.m. on December 8, 2014 in the 1st floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

Present: Chair Albrecht, Commissioner Emler and Commissioner Apple.

The following were considered by the Commission:

1. Consent Agenda: Commissioner Emler moved for approval of the Consent Agenda: All other listed matters as presented for December 8, 2014 on the 3 page document attached hereto as "Attachment A," which is included by reference. Commissioner Apple seconded the Motion. Commissioner Albrecht concurred. Motion was approved.

2. Noticed:

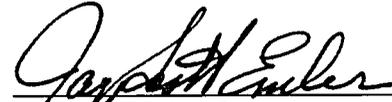

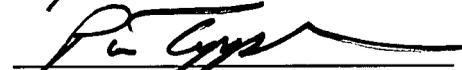
