The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on February 3, 2015 in the 1st floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

The Commission moved into Executive Session 10:00 a.m. and reconvened in public session at 10:40 a.m.


No action was taken.






