**MINUTES**

The Commission convened the regular scheduled business meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on March 24, 2015 in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 SW Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

Present: Chair Albrecht, Commissioner Emler and Commissioner Apple. The following were considered by the Commission:

1. **Consent Agenda:** Commissioner Albrecht moved to table items 1 – 25 from the Consent Agenda listed from the March 24, 2015 on the 5 page document attached hereto as "Attachment A," which is included by reference herein. Commissioner Emler seconded the Motion. Commissioner Apple concurred. Motion was approved.


The Commission moved into Executive Session at 10:30 a.m. and reconvened in public session at 11:30 a.m.

**The Commission took no action following this Executive Session.**




