**MINUTES**

The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on March 31, 2015 in the 1<sup>st</sup> floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 SW Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

Present: Chair Albrecht and Commissioner Apple. Commissioner Emler was absent. The following were considered by the Commission:
