MINUTES

The April 16, 2015 regular scheduled meeting of the Kansas Corporation Commission was called to order at 10:00 a.m. in the 1st floor hearing room at 1500 SW Arrowhead Road, Topeka, Kansas.

Chair Albrecht and Commissioner Apple were present. Commissioner Emler was not in attendance.

The following items were considered by the Commission:

1. **Consent Agenda:** Commissioner Apple moved to approve the Consent Agenda: All other listed matters as presented for April 16, 2015 on the 4 page document attached hereto as "Attachment A," which is included by reference herein. Commissioner Albrecht seconded the Motion. Motion was approved.

2. **Noticed:**

- B. Chair Albrecht moved to recess the commission meeting to conduct the public hearing on Rules & Regulations at 10:09 a.m. and to reconvene the commission meeting at 10:30 a.m. Commissioner Apple seconded. Motion was approved.

The Commission moved into Executive Session at 12:10 p.m.. in the 3rd Floor Commission Conference Room, and reconvened in public session at 12:55 p.m.

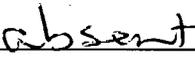
The Commission took no action following this Executive Session.

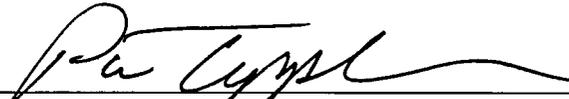
