MINUTES

The Commission convened the regular scheduled business meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on June 16, 2015 in the 1st floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

Present: Chair Albrecht, Commissioner Emler and Commissioner Apple.

The following were considered by the Commission:

1. Addition to the Business Meeting agenda of a Public Hearing for K.A.R. 82-4-3a.
2. **Consent Agenda:** Commissioner Emler moved for approval of the Consent Agenda: All other listed matters as presented for June 16, 2015 on the 4 page document attached hereto as "Attachment A," which is included by reference herein. Commissioner Apple seconded the Motion. Commissioner Albrecht concurred. Motion was approved.
3. **Noticed:**
 - A. **Docket No. 15-WSEE-115-RTS: *In the Matter of the Application of Westar Energy, Inc. and Kansas Gas and Electric Company to Make Certain Changes in Their Charges for Electric Service.***

Commissioner Emler moved for approval of order #15-1886 - *Order Denying Petition to Intervene of Cromwell Environmental, Inc. and Aron Cromwell.* Commissioner Apple seconded the motion. Commissioner Albrecht concurred. Motion was approved.

Commissioner Emler moved for approval of order #15-1950 - *Order on C12 Kansas's Petition for Reconsideration of the Commission's Order Denying Application.* Commissioner Apple seconded the motion. Commissioner Albrecht concurred. Motion was approved.

4. **Other matters:**
 - A. To avoid last minute settlements and lost hearing preparation time, Commissioner Emler requested Commission legal staff develop a bright line date before evidentiary hearings after which settlement could no longer be pursued.
 - B. Chair Albrecht moved the Business Meeting into the Public Hearing on a Motor Carrier Proposed Administrative Regulation K.A.R. 82-4-3a. Hours of service; Michael Duenes was the presenter. No commenters appeared and no comments were received.

- C. Chair Albrecht moved to meet in Executive Session for Personnel matters of non-elected personnel, pursuant to KSA 75-4319(b)(1), to protect the privacy of the individuals involved, for a period of 15 minutes. Commissioner Emler seconded. Commissioner Apple concurred.

The Commission moved into Executive Session at 10:23 a.m. and reconvened in public session at 10:38 a.m.


The Commission took no action following this Executive Session.






