MINUTES

The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on July 2, 2015 in the 1st floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 SW Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

Present: Chair Albrecht, Commissioner Emler and Commissioner Apple. The following were considered by the Commission:

The Commission took no action following this Executive Session.



The Commission moved into Executive Session at 10:57 a.m. and reconvened in public session at 11:12 a.m.


The Commission took no action following this Executive Session.


