MINUTES

The Commission convened the regular scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on October 27, 2016 in the Commission Conservation Division of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 266 N Main St, Suite 200, Wichita, Kansas.

Present: Chairman Emler, Commissioner Albrecht and Commissioner Apple. The following were considered by the Commission:

1. Noticed:

2. Other matters:


- A. ***FERC Matter:*** Presenter Michael Duenes, Assistant General Counsel.


The motion was approved.


