MINUTES

The Commission convened the regularly scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:00 a.m. on March 16, 2017 in the 1st floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

Present: Chairman Apple, and Commissioner Emler. Commissioner Albrecht attended via telephone. The following were considered by the Commission:

Commissioner Emler moved for approval of order #17-0987 - *Final Order*. Commissioner Albrecht seconded the motion.

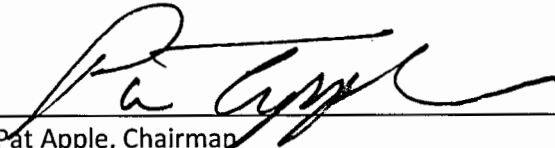
The motion was approved.

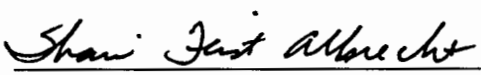

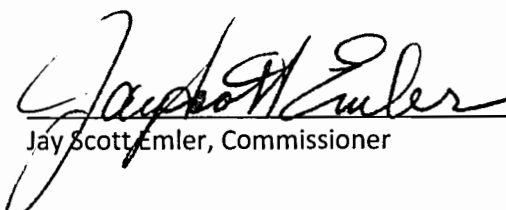

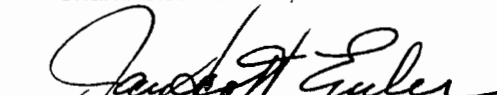
