The motion was approved.

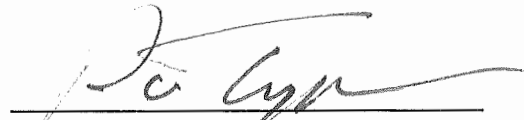
The Commission moved into Executive Session at 10:23 a.m. and reconvened in public session at 10:33 a.m.

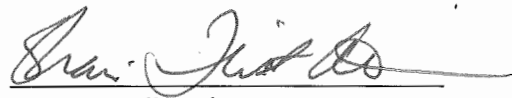
The Commission took no action following the Executive Session.

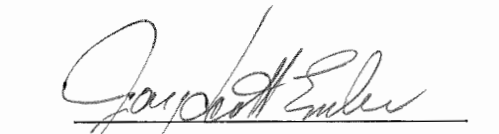
