The Commission moved into Executive Session at 10:02 a.m. and reconvened in public session at 10:12 a.m.

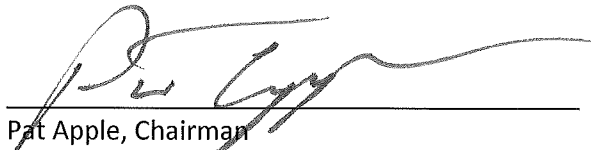
- C. The Commission took no action following this Executive Session:

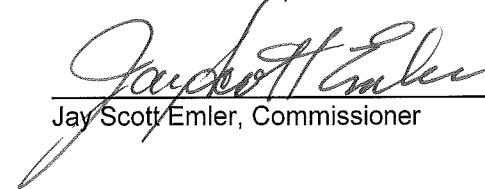
