
The motion was approved.



Re: Replacement of agency vehicles

I request approval to procure eight replacement vehicles. Of those vehicles, five will be utilized in the Conservation Division, two will be utilized in the pipeline safety program and one will be utilized in the Transportation Division.

The Conservation Division director would like to have the option of replacing an additional four vehicles later in the fiscal year if it is determined they are needed. These replacements are requested in accordance with approved budgets.

All replacements will be purchased from the statewide vehicle contract at an estimated cost of \$24,800 per vehicle.



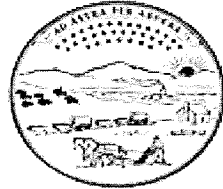
