## Project Highlights

Buhler Unified School District is the first school district in Kansas to utilize the Facility Conservation Improvement Program (FCIP). Through this program the school district was able to implement \$1.2 million in energy-efficient facility upgrades and infrastructure improvements.

The failing boiler and chiller systems in the middle school will be replaced which will reduce the possibility of unplanned school closings. Participation in this program demonstrates to taxpayers that the administration is committed to using existing funds wisely during tough financial times.
