As president of ITC Great Plains, Kansas native Carl Huslig is dedicated to meeting the energy needs of Kansas and the Great Plains area through the development of electricity transmission infrastructural improvements.

Mr. Huslig has personally testified in front of the Kansas Corporation Commission (Feb 2005) to the lack of regional electricity transfer capability within Kansas.
