MINUTES

The Commission convened the regularly scheduled open meeting of the Commission at 10:01 a.m. on September 3, 2020, in the 1st floor hearing room of the Kansas Corporation Commission, 1500 Arrowhead, Topeka, Kansas.

Present: Chair Duffy, Commissioner Keen, and Commissioner French. The following were considered by the Commission:

1. **Consent Agenda:** Commissioner Keen moved for approval of the Items on the Consent Agenda dated September 3, 2020, containing pages one through four and are attached to these Minutes. Chair Duffy seconded the motion.

C. **Docket No. 21-GIMT-095-GIT**




The order is approved.






